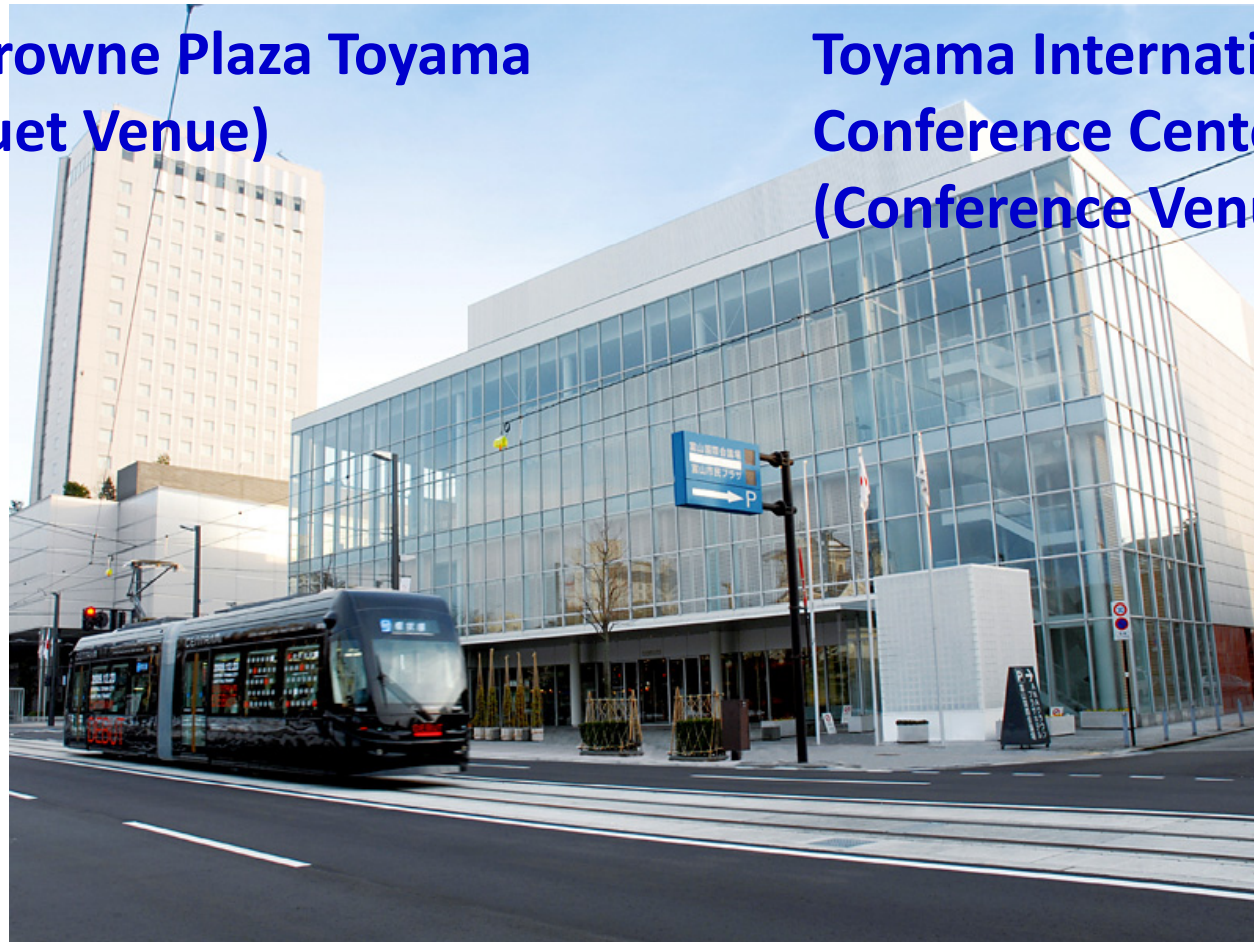

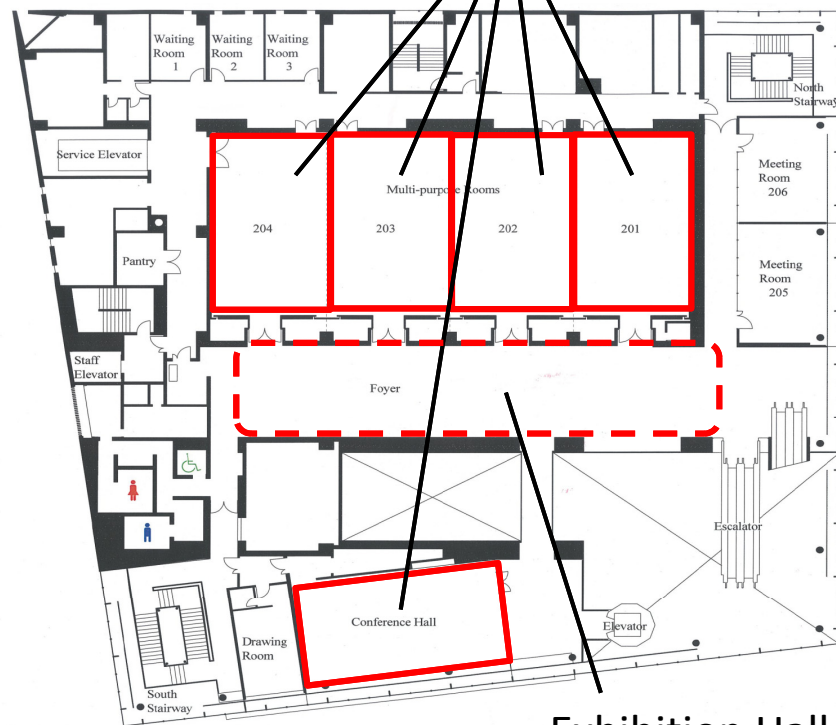

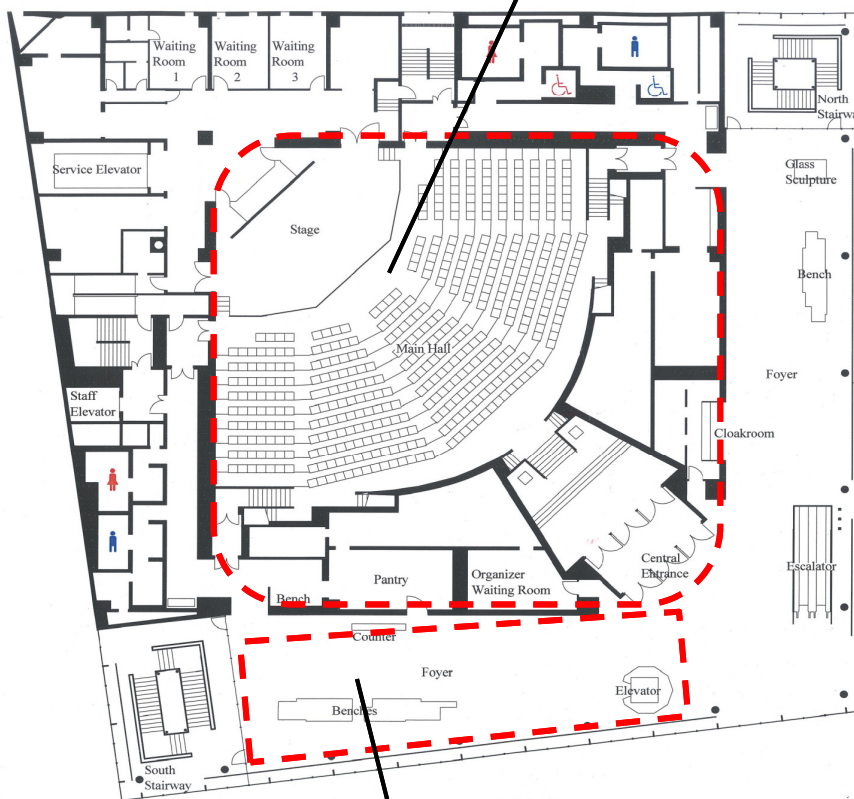

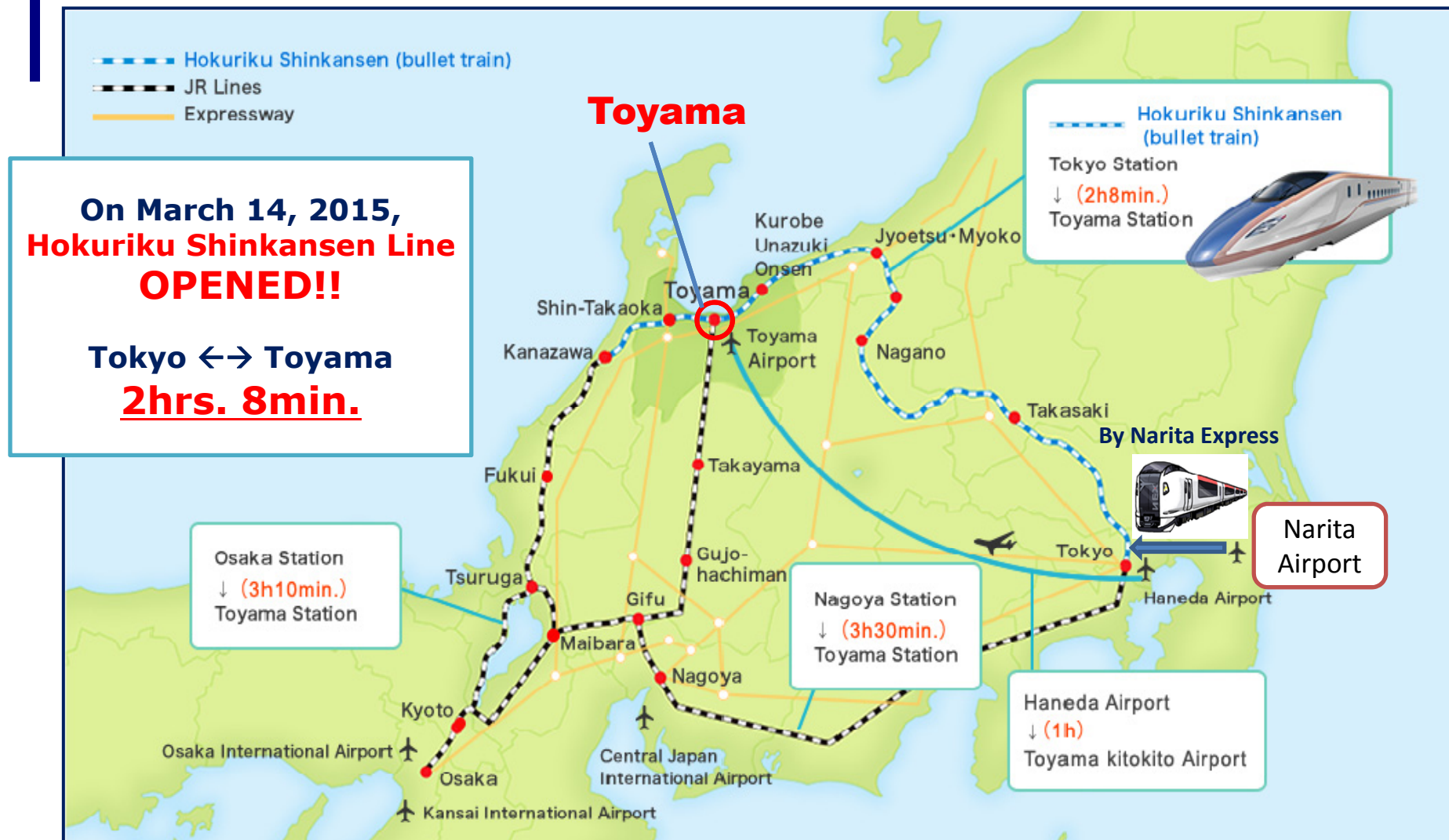

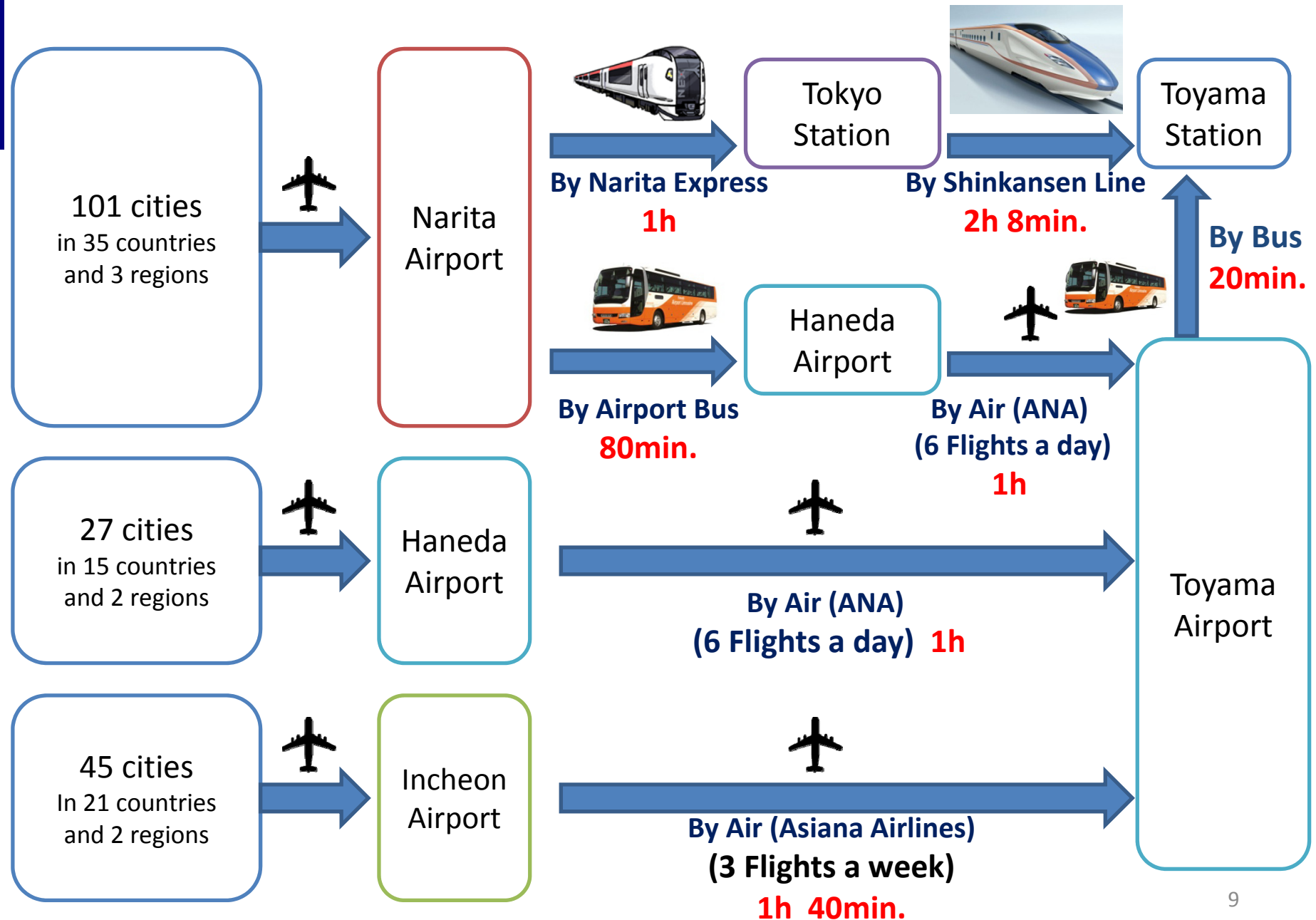

Access to Toyama by land

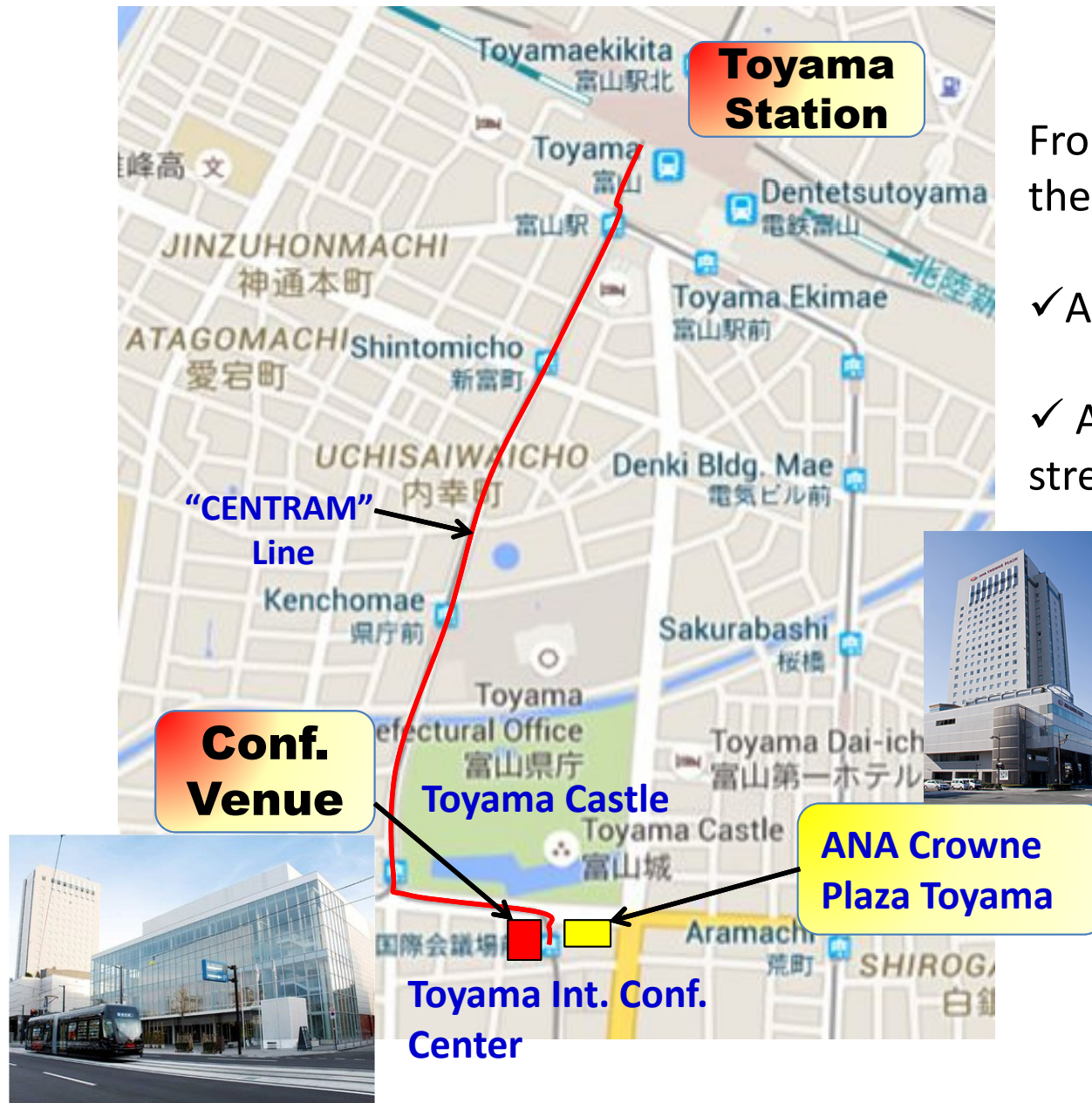

The Location and Beautiful Nature

Toyama is located between the coast of the Sea of Japan and Tateyama Mountain Range, which is one of Japanese National Parks. Therefore, Toyama is close to both sea coast and mountain. You can access the beautiful natures distributing near Toyama in the range closer than about 60 km. For example, **Tateyama Mountain Range**, the famous Japanese Garden, **“Kenroku-En”**, **Noto Peninsula** and Japanese old villages such as **“Shirakawa and Gokayama Village”**, a historical cite of World Heritage.

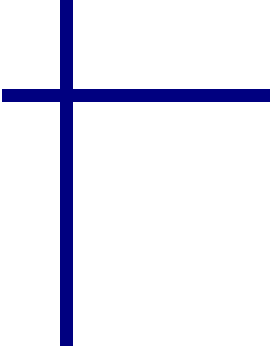
