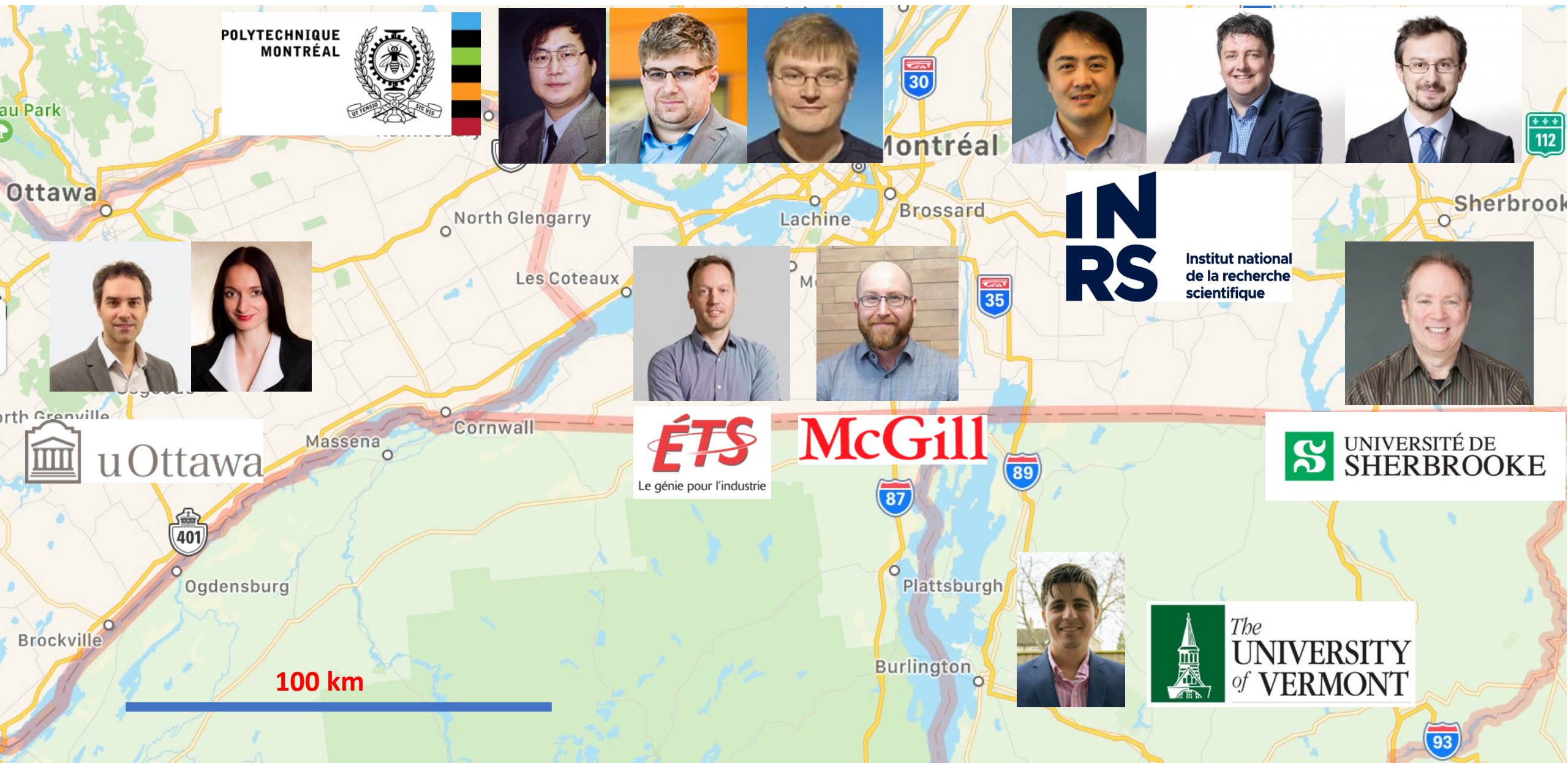

- Hotel shuttle bus (40 min)





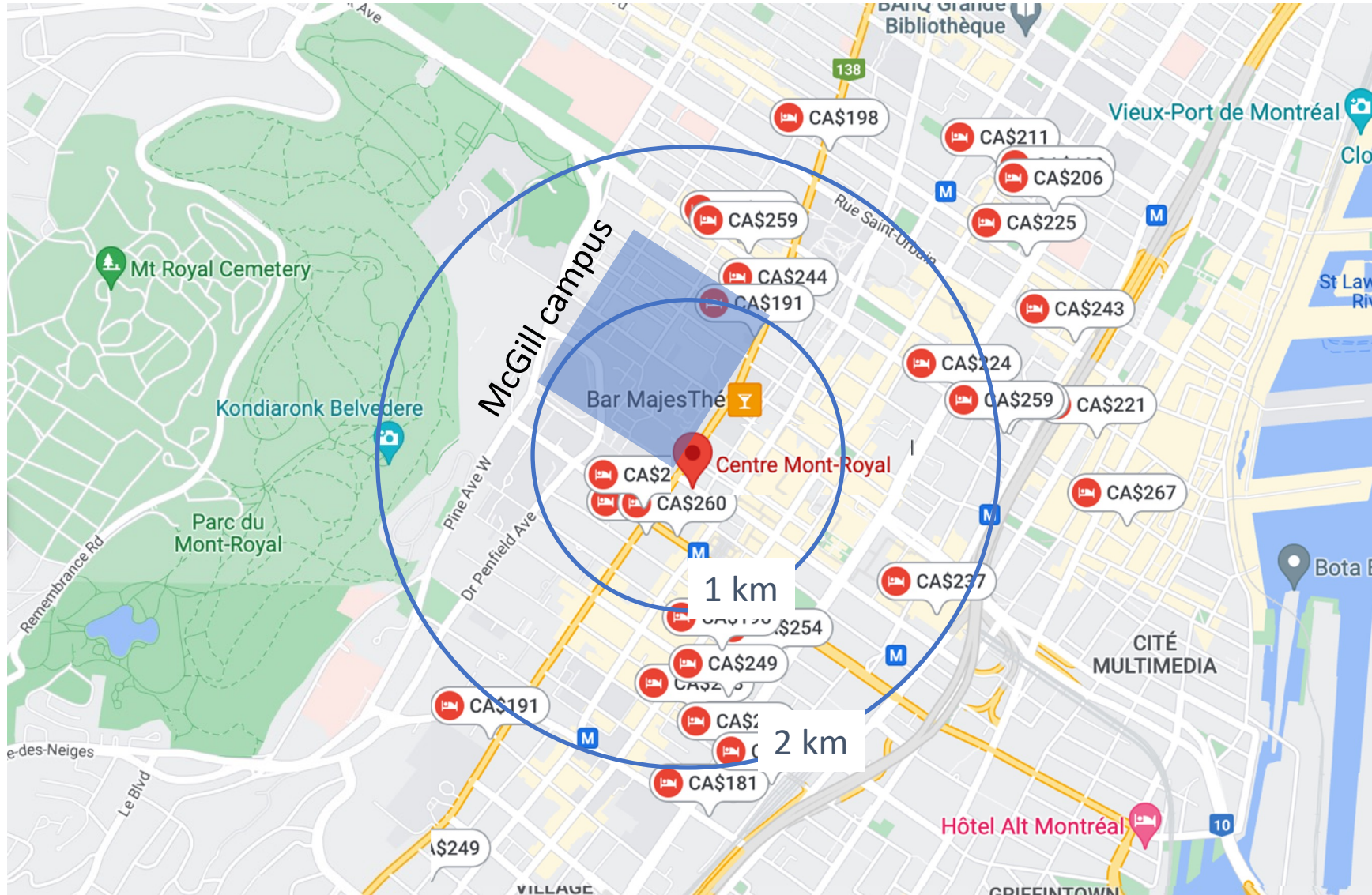
Easy to get around

- 32 km of underground network

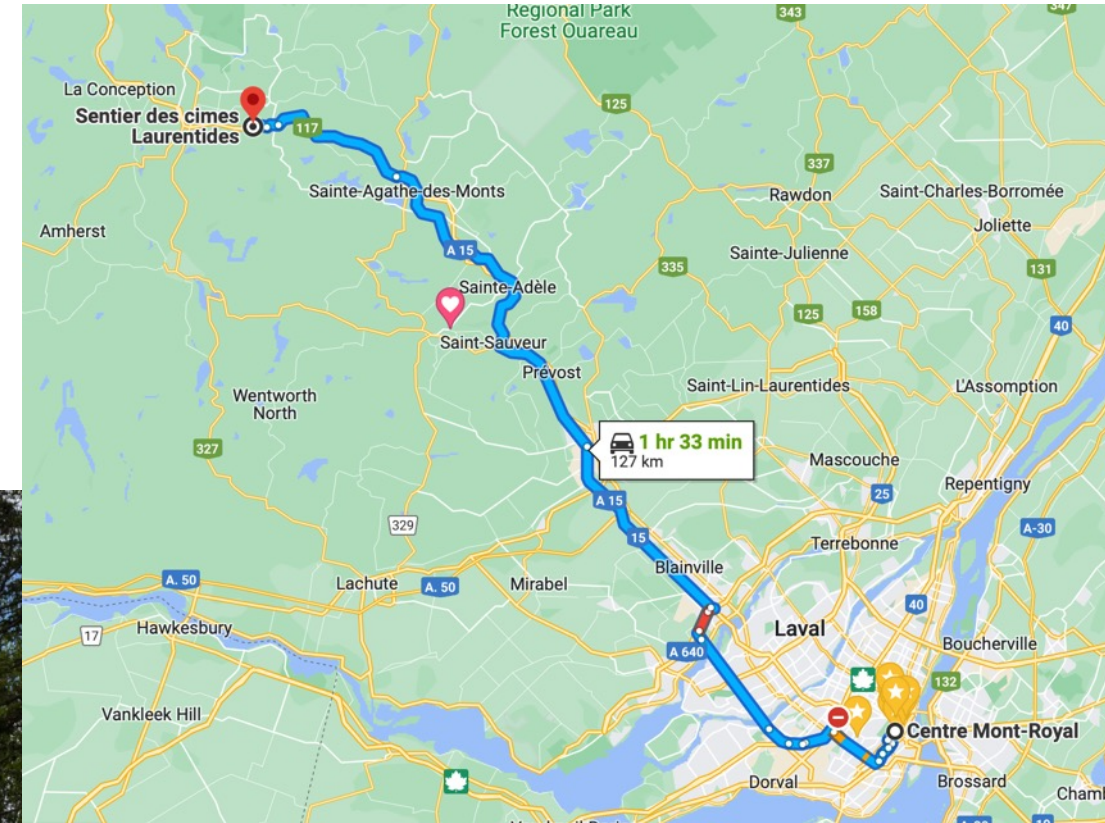
Venue: Centre Mont-Royal
